So, You Want to Go to an Ivy League College?

Tips for K-12 Students Aiming for Admission to Any Highly Selective College

While there are around 5,300 colleges and universities in the United States, many students set their sights on just a handful. This group often includes the most highly selective institutions, such as Stanford and MIT, and usually includes one, some, or all of the eight Ivy League colleges (Brown, Columbia, Cornell, Dartmouth, Harvard, Princeton, University of Pennsylvania, and Yale).
